New Password Field

Effective 14/11/22, the WinTrade password keypad has been replaced with a password field to simplify system sign-in and streamline the transaction approval process.

There is no change to your current WinTrade password.

Type your **current password** into the password field to sign in to WinTrade or approve transactions.

Please note: you do not need to change your current password in order to use the new screen.

Enter your password, then click **Approve**.



How to format a new WinTrade password

The WinTrade password format has been enhanced to provide greater flexibility for users to create a memorable password or pass phrase that is unique to their banking.

If you decide to change your WinTrade password in the future, you will need to use the following requirements.

What are the minimum requirements?

- Minimum 8-30 characters.
- Must contain 1 letter, 1 number and a special character/symbol.

What is allowed?

- A-Z (both upper and lower case).
- Numerical values 0-9.
- Special characters/symbols ~@#\$^*()+\<>"";`&%!/=[]{}|,.?:-

What is not allowed?

- Password cannot contain spaces.
- Password cannot be the same as any of your previous 3 passwords used for WinTrade.
- No more than 2 repeating characters in a row. (e.g. AAB, 112, @@! is allowed. AAA, 111, @@@@ is not)
